CONSENTAGENDA ITEM 3. C:BUDGET RESOLUTION

BACKGROUND:

This resolution budgets the following:

- Transfers \$218,036 of Port cash to Hurricane Ian Storm FY22 account for repairs to warehouses 8, 9, and 11 due to damages caused by Hurricane Ian.
- Budgets the balance of \$1,257 for the Seaport Security Initiative project funded \$943 by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and \$314 Port cash. This project was inadvertently closed and is pending final reimbursement from FDOT.
- \$5,400 of cash for Port capital grant costs to incorporate the 2022 Master Plan into the County's Comprehensive Plan.
- \$5,000,000 for the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Public Transportation Grant Agreement (PTGA) Amendment for a second mobile harbor crane funded by 50% FDOT in the amount of \$2,500,000 and 50% Port cash of \$2,500,000.
- Decrease \$13,574 of the Port Capital Improvement expense to close out the completed Railroad Upgrade and Replacement project and transfer to Port cash.

RESOLUTION PA-23-25 AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR MANATEE COUNTY PORT AUTHORITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023

WHEREAS, Sections 129.06 and 180.016, Florida Statutes, authorizes the Manatee County Port Authority to amend its budget for the current fiscal year as follows:

- a) Appropriations for expenditures in any fund may be decreased and other appropriations in the same fund correspondingly increased, provided the total appropriations of the fund are not changed.
- b) Appropriations from reserves may be made to increase the appropriation for any particular expense in the same fund, or to create an appropriation in the fund for any lawful purpose.
- c) Unanticipated revenues, including increased receipts for enterprise or propriety funds, may be appropriated for their intended purpose, and may be transferred between funds to properly account for the unanticipated revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Manatee County Port Authority that the 2022-2023 budget is hereby amended in accordance with Section 129.06 and 180.016, Florida Statutes as described on the attached summary and specified in the budget adjustment batch files which are listed below:
