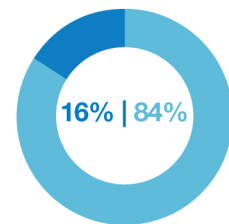

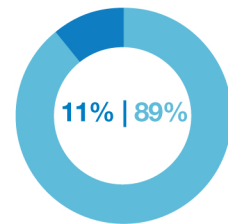

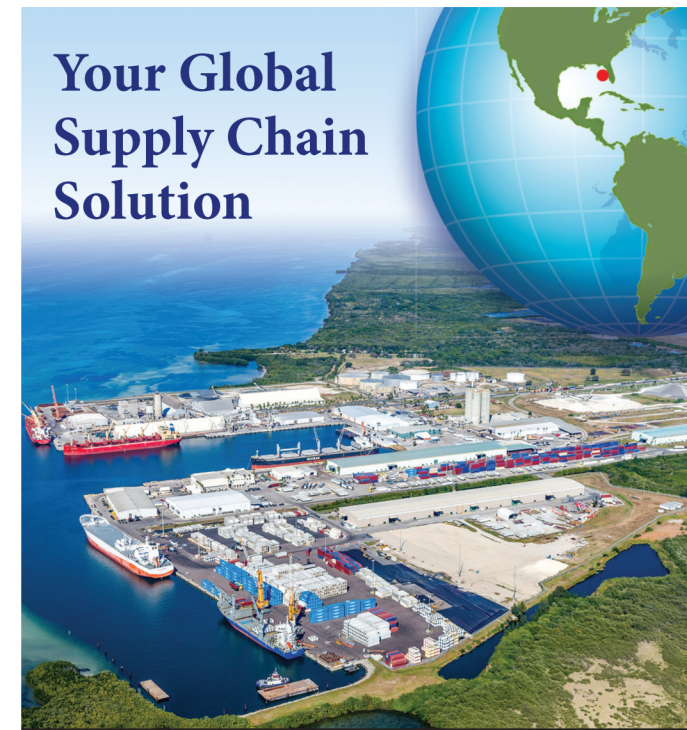

SeaPort Manatee's fourth year of increased exports and its third year of breaking the previous year's export record total.

\$102,494,898

Exports of machines for heating and sterilizing became the most valuable export for the first time since 2019, increasing 231.55% over the last five years.

\$1,000,000

Seventeen of SeaPort Manatee's exports were valued more than \$1 million dollars, breaking the 2022 record of 14.

1,000%

Five exports grew by over 1,000 percent including metal sheeting gaskets, frozen beef, makeup and skincare products, computers and motor vehicle chassis.

\$1,835,399,879

SeaPort Manatee reached its third consecutive year with more than \$1 billion dollars in imports in 2023. The Port registered imports in 123 out of more than 1,200 categories from 35 countries.

\$100,373,426

Imports of the category including pineapples topped \$100 million for the first time, having grown in value for three consecutive years.



\$19,164,787

Biodiesel fuel imports came back after a five-year hiatus. In 2016 and 2017, it had been the 5th most important import.

50.47%

The top 5 imports account for just over 50% of all import trade.

SeaPort Manatee has three imports ranking in the top five in the U.S.: natural calcium and phosphate ranks second, fruit and vegetable juices ranks third; and pebbles, gravel ranks fourth.

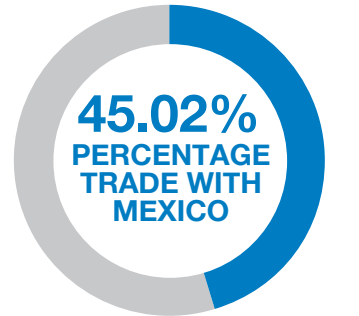
